

Confirmation Requirements Contract

Each Candidate must:

- Attend Mass weekly beginning in 7th Grade through Confirmation including the summer and submit 14 signed Homily Reflections each year. Please see guidelines for Homily Reflection requirements and dates.
- Attend scheduled classes – after 4 unexcused absences, the student will repeat the grade level the following year.
- Seventh Grade student and parent must attend Confirmation Meeting. There are no make-up meetings, and the candidate is responsible for the information covered at the meeting.
- Know the required lessons, prayers, and confirmation questions. Interviews with candidates will be conducted in 8th grade. Interview cannot be made up or rescheduled. Please see calendar for dates.
- Attend Sponsor and Candidate retreat in January of 8th Grade. If Sponsor cannot attend, candidate must attend with a parent. Please see schedule. There is no make up for this retreat. Confirmation will be delayed until the following year when retreat is attended.
- Attend Candidate Spirit confirmation retreat in 8th grade. Please see schedule. If a student misses the retreat, confirmation will be delayed as the retreat cannot be made up.
- Submit Saint Poster together with worksheet for the story of your Saint.
- Submit Confirmation Letter to Father Mike by assigned date in December of 8th grade.
- Submit completed confirmation packet and sponsor eligibility form to Religious Education Office by assigned date in January of 8th Grade. You will have almost 1 year to complete packet.
- Perform 20 hours of church and/or community service hours per year. Service must be performed within a supervised organization that has been approved by Father Mike and the DRE. 15 hours are to be performed at the Church of Epiphany and the additional 5 hours can be performed at the Church of Epiphany or at one of the organized approved organizations. All hours must be submitted on the log sheet and must be signed by the person in charge of the event and include a telephone number. Parents and/or relatives are not permitted to sign for service hours. It is the student's responsibility to keep track of the hours. Please see confirmation packet for deadline dates.
