Homily Reflection Guidelines

- 14 Homily Reflections written in journals with a raised seal
 - 9 masses anytime from July 1, 2021 – April 10, 2022. Must be completed at Church of Epiphany
 - 3 Mandatory Class Mass – Must be completed at Church of Epiphany ~ If you are unable to make your scheduled Mass, you will have to obtain prior approval from Kim Lorentzen DRE – please email her at kim@churchofepiphany.org **(only 1 make up mass permitted)**
 - Christmas & Easter Masses – attendance preferred at Epiphany: however, if traveling can be completed at any **Catholic Mass and signed by Priest or Deacon. Bulletins will not be accepted.**
- Any Journal entry without a date or seal will not be accepted
- Journals must be handed into the Religious Ed office **at time of registration.**
 - Journals need to be in chronological order
 - Dates & name of homeliest must be legible
 - Each entry must be completed with a written entry done by student
 - Each entry must have a seal
- The accountability and responsibility of the Homily Reflection Journal is that of the student and parents. The Religious Ed Department will no longer be granting extensions and or sending out past due notices for failure to meet requirements.
- Please note the Homily Reflection Journal is a requirement of the Church of Epiphany's Faith Formation Program and must be completed on time in order to register for the following academic year.
