

The Sacrament of Baptism is ordinarily celebrated the 2nd and 4th Sundays of each month at 12:00 pm. To schedule Baptism, please call the Parish Office, at least one month in advance.

#### Sponsor Letters/Requirements

The following is required by Canon Law to be a Catholic Godparent/Sponsor for **Baptism** Confirmation. Be at least 16 years of age. Have completed the Sacraments of Initiation. (Baptism, Eucharist & Confirmation). If married, have a marriage that is canonically valid and recognized by the Catholic Church. Be a registered and active parishioner living a life of faith. You must be registered with our parish for at least 3 months before we will provide a sponsor letter. Although you may have registered with our parish, if you are not attending Mass regularly and using the envelope system there is no way for the parish office to confirm regular Mass attendance. Please contact the Parish Office to confirm your status with our parish.

## **Eucharistic Adoration: Every Wed. 3-6PM**Things to do during Eucharistic Adoration

Fr. Benedict Groeschel has said there are "four kinds of prayer most appropriate in the presence of the Eucharist, namely adoration and praise, thanksgiving, repentance, and trusting intercession." Some suggestions:

- 1. Come and adore Him. Thank Him for all He has done and then pour out your heart to Him.
- Sit quietly and "just be" in the Presence of God. Instead of talking to the Lord, try listening to what He wants to tell you.
- Recite the "Jesus Prayer", "Lord Jesus, have mercy on me, a sinner", repeatedly as you quiet your heart and mind. Then ask for forgiveness and intercede for others.
- 4. Pray the Rosary, Divine Mercy or Liturgy of the Hours
- Meditate using Scripture. Choose a passage from the Bible Read the words a few times and if something strikes you, ask the Holy Spirit to let them speak to you. Ask what God wants you to understand from that and write it down.

Gospel: John 14:23-29

Jesus tells his disciples, "Anyone who loves me will be true to my word." For those who do honor his word, both Jesus and God will love them and stay with them always. He also tells them that God will send the Holy Spirit in his place to give them the instructions they will need. Jesus then tells them that peace is his farewell gift to them.

"Jesus said, 'Whoever loves me will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our dwelling with him... I have told you this while I was still with you. The Advocate, the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send you in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of everything I have taught you... Peace I leave with you, my peace I give to you."

How often Jesus' role is described as teacher, preacher and miracle worker. Today He places emphasis on His teaching mission as He promises to send the Holy Spirit to teach and remind us of His message. The Lord knows we sometimes forget and need to be reminded of His word and His wish to abide with us. As He was preparing to take leave, He knew we needed additional help and for this reason promises us a gift. He offers us the gift of His peace. Do you still have it? Can you make it your gift for someone else? It was given to you to be given away.






